Table 2: Criteria Used to Assess Each Variable

Variables	Criteria/Indicator
Internet Connectivity (3G/4G)	Percentage of population covered by 3G/4G networks (urban vs. rural coverage, availability by country)
Broadband Penetration	Fixed broadband subscriptions per 100 inhabitants, GDP per capita
Digital Device Affordability	Cost of entry-level smartphones, Price of 1GB mobile data as a percentage of Gross National Income (GNI)
Telehealth Readiness	Infrastructure capacity for digital health services, including broadband and mobile networks (rural and urban)
Digital Divide	Disparities in digital access, including the gender digital gap and rural-urban connectivity

Figure 1: Telehealth Readiness Variables by African Region

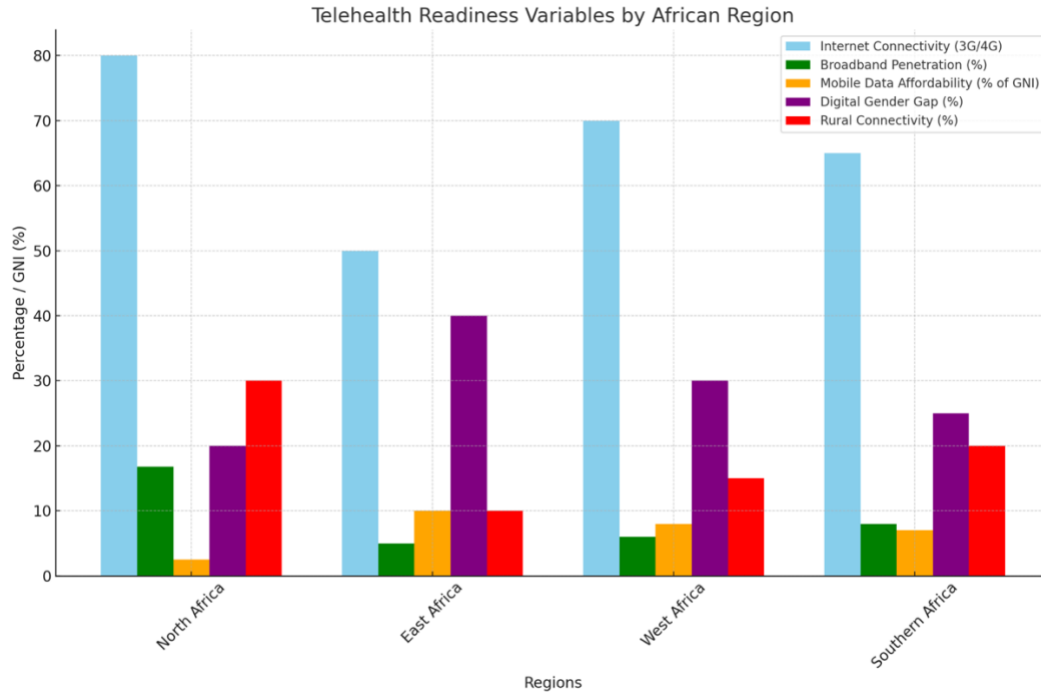


Figure 2: Comparative Analysis of Telehealth Readiness: North Africa vs. Sub-Saharan Africa

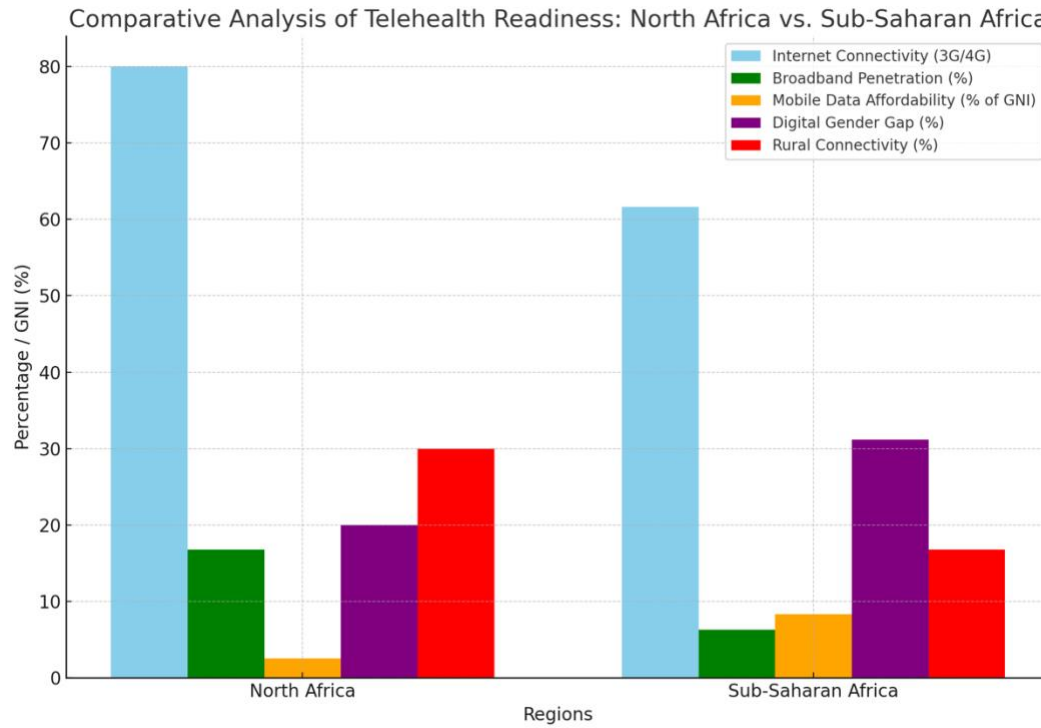


Figure 3: Correlation Heatmap of Telehealth Readiness Variables
